Comments

Source is quite far off-axis. The PSF is asymmetric and contains the pattern of the struts. The zeroth order is not found at the precise center of the PSF, but is within about 1 arcsec. The off-axis position yields a plus side spectrum with energies beyond 100 A. The minus side spectrum is truncated.

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Standard software processing technique using the tool tgdetect failed to determine an accurate position for the zeroth order for this observation. The source is extended and asymmetric. due to the off-axis PSF. The processing software defaulted to the coordinates supplied by the user for the position of the zeroth order for the grating spectral extraction.
