Comments

HETG is inserted as a filter; there is very little useful gratings information in the observation. The zeroth order position used in the grating extraction is NOT at the position of the pulsar, but is near some bright emission knots to the SE. If the dispersed grating spectrum is to be analyzed, it should be re-extracted using the exact position of the pulsar as the zeroth order position. The dispersed spectrum only contains data for the meg orders between 1-2 A.

Broad east/west streak in Level 2 data is instrumental, due to the fact that the spacecraft dither during this observation was only 1 arcsec.
