Zeroth order piled up. Standard data processing software did not correctly locate the zeroth order due to pileup. Manual intervention was used to input the correct sky coordinates ( $x=4269.94$ ,  $y=4307.81$ ) into the `*src1a.fits` file table. These corrected coordinates were determined using a software tool developed by CXC called `findzero`, which is expected to be released in CIAO (currently in ISIS). The tool calculates the point of intersection of the readout streak and the leg arm. The zeroth order source position determined by the standard pipeline processing using the tool `tgdetect` was not used in this processing. The newly determined zeroth order coordinates have been placed in the `*src1a.fits` file, replacing the coordinates determined by `tgdetect`. Note that these corrected coordinates of the zeroth order cannot be reproduced by running `tgdetect` on the data.
