The data contain 2 spectra. The binary separation is about 5 arcsec in the cross-dispersion direction. Care should be taken to extract the sources separately. In this processing, the zeroth order position for spectral extraction is centered on the star in the northwest position, although standard processing has been used and no attempt has been made to exclude the second star from the background.
